Both the Boys and Girls Tournament will be held on Friday, March 19 and run at the same time.

Location

Northway Lanes, 1751 Evanston Avenue, Muskegon, MI 49442. Northway has hosted many MHSAA Regionals and State Finals and is home to eight high school bowling programs.

Time Schedule -

- 7:30 Check-in & registration (bowlers go immediately to starting lanes)
- 8:00 Coaches meeting
- 8:40 Warm-up period (15 minutes)
- 8:55 National Anthem and Introductions
- 9:00 Bowling Begins

Entry Limits/Regional Bowling Format

A maximum of 6 eligible athletes are allowed. Teams will have five bowlers and one substitute. Each of the five bowlers rolls four games. For Regional level, these games count toward Team totals AND for Singles, so you are bowling for both competitions at the same time. There are NO Bakers, and only FIVE bowlers will be attempting to qualify for the Singles Finals. The substitute (6th bowler) can be used as normal, but if a substitute is used both the sub and the initial bowler are **ineligible** to qualify for the Singles Finals. In this four-game format, each of the five athletes wbowl four games for a total of 20 games for the Team total. The tournament roster may change from one level to the next (Regional to Finals).

Finances

Schools participating in the MHSAA Regional tournament pay all expenses and fees for their schools. The fee is \$60/team entered. Please make checks payable to Northway Lanes and bring with you or mail to Orchard View Athletics, 16 N. Quarterline Rd., Muskegon, MI 49442.

Awards

Each Regional Champion will receive a team trophy and eight team medals. Medals will be given to the tp 10 places for the Regional singles event

Coaching

Only two coaches per gender will be allowed. Coaches are not allowed on the approaches. Direct coaching and/or instruction are only allowed between frames.

Pace of Play

Bowlers should be standing and ready to bowl when the preceding bowler is completing his/her frame with a one lane courtesy. Intentional stalling or undue delay is considered unsportsmanlike. Bowlers will be warned about such conduct and may be penalized if there are repeated violations.

Substitutions & Lineups – A starting team lineup must be determined 10 minutes prior to the start of thefirst team game. A starting lineup for team and singles competition will consist of 5 bowlers. Starting bowlers must bowl at least one frame before being substituted for. Once a substitute enters the game, s/he must finish that game. Substitutions in mid-frame are allowed. The bowler who is substituted for may return as a starter or substitute in subsequent games. The substitute must be on the 6-person rosterat the start of competition or on

the school's master eligibility list prior to competition. The substitute (6th bowler) can be used as normal, but if a substitute is used both the sub and the initial bowler are ineligible to qualify for the Singles Finals. Any of the five starting bowlers may be substituted for in any given game. If a substitute is injured or ill, they may be replaced by an eligible student who appears on the school's master eligibility list. **Substitutes may not warm up on open lanes.** Scratches or deletions from MHSAA Regional should occur as early as possible and no later than the Monday prior to competition.

Uniforms

MHSAA regular season dress code should be adhered to.

Spectators

NO SPECTATORS WILL BE ALLOWED, however each team may have one person to live-stream their matches on whatever platform they choose. This regulation has been relaxed for this year only.

Concessions:

Concessions will be provided. No outside food or drink allowed in the facility.

Lane Conditions

The "Allen pattern" will be used.

Tiebreaker Procedures

Team ties will be broken by best team game of the series. Singles ties will be broken by best game of the series.
