Bowling Fees

The cost for bowling in Region 21 is \$50 per team. Schools with boys and girls teams will pay \$100. If you are brining less than 5 bowlers the cost is \$10 per bowler.

All fees must be made payable to **Jax 60**.

Checks are due on the day of competition NO EXCEPTIONS- or you will not be allowed to compete. DO NOT mail payment to the bowling center. Checks MUST be presented by a coach at check in on the day of event! NO EXCEPTIONS!

Spectators and Admission

The MHSAA is allowing one (1) spectator per bowler. The MHSAA will use digital ticketing (GoFan) at all Regional sites. Ticket price will be \$10.00 per spectator.

It is for this reason of limited spectators, that we encourage live streaming of bowling regionals by whatever means that works best for your center, your team and your spectators that can't attend. As long as this streaming does not impact bowling or student-athletes in any way, we encourage you to provide this service so that parents and others can watch and follow scores of their favorite bowler and team.

Food or Beverages

No outside food or beverages are allowed to be brought into the bowling center

<u>Valuables</u>

Please do not bring in any of your valuables (iPads, iPods, etc.) to the bowling center. The MHSAA, Jax 60 or Hanover-Horton High School cannot be responsible for lost or stolen items.

Regional Format

- Teams will have five bowlers and one substitute.
- Each of the five bowlers roll four games. These games count toward Team totals AND for Singles, so you are bowling for both competitions at the same time.
 There are NO Bakers, and only FIVE bowlers will be attempting to qualify for the Singles Finals.
- The substitute (6th bowler) can be used as normal, but if a substitute is used both the sub and the initial bowler are ineligible to qualify for the Singles Finals.
- In this four-game format, each of the five athletes would bowl four games for a total of 20 games for the Team total.
- Bowlers will bowl with their teammates on the same pair and will rotate pairs after each game bowled.



- Team ties will be broken by best team game of the series. Singles ties will be broken by best game of the series.
- The top TWO teams move on to MHSAA Finals. The top TEN Singles move on to MHSAA Finals.
- There will be 12 teams per gender and per division in the MHSAA Finals. There will be 60 bowlers per gender and per division.

Regional Bowling Ball limits

Because of this year's Regional format, space between pairs of lanes in most centers will be open. With the additional space, the restriction of bowling ball limits is being lifted and <u>increased to 4 balls per participant in the bowling center</u>. There is still as strong recommendation that paddocks are not used or if they are, that only one person be allowed into the paddock at a time.

Coach limits

To limit the number of people inside a house on Regional day, the number of coaches per team will be limited to **two coaches per gender per school**. We also encourage schools to limit that number if possible and if you have one coach per team, that is the number you should have on site. This is not the time to add coaches.

Stay Safe

Please also talk with all of your bowlers and families about the importance of keeping everyone safe as we are in the final days of the regular season and headed into the tournament. Please communicate again with parents and bowlers to stay safe, communicate if anyone doesn't feel well for any reason so the right decisions can be made. Communication will be the key between schools, coaches, bowlers and families!

Uniform/Dress Code

Boys – Slacks and a collared shirt or mock turtleneck are required.

Girls – Slacks, shorts or skirt with a collared shirt or mock turtleneck are required. Skirts must reach the top of the knee and shorts shall be an appropriate length. No yoga pants.

All – No jeans, cutoffs, sweatpants or warm-up pants. Also no hats, caps or any type of headgear are allowed.

Coaches must also adhere to the MHSAA uniform/dress code regulations.

<u>Practice</u>

Bowlers may practice at Jax 60 prior to the MHSAA Regional dates during normal open bowling time at normal rates. No practice is allowed on days of MHSAA competition.
