Entries:

All 2021 MHSAA Regional meets will be using Athletic.net. Entries must be received by Friday, May 14th at 8:00 pm. There is a late fee of \$50 if this is not in on time. Seed times must be entered as FAT. Entries for whom times were not submitted or for whom confirmed false times were submitted, are to be placed in the last heat or first section without seeding consideration. The Regional Manager is to advise the MHSAA, in writing, of these violations. A maximum of THREE INDIVIDUALS may be listed by a school for each bona fide team in EACH INDIVIDUAL EVENT at the Lower Peninsula Regional Meets. However, only two may compete unless all three or more have met the additional qualifier standard. If three or more entries by a school team in an event have equaled or bettered the published additional qualifier standard, compiled from the results of the most recent outdoor seasons, all of these entries may enter and compete in the Regional Meet in that event.

Coaches Meeting:

There will be a coaches meeting at 8:00 am near the timing trailer at the main starting line of the track. Scratches may be made at that time. Scratches for the morning session will be accepted until 8:30 am and afternoon session until 12:00 pm. Each Regional Manager will accept scratches before each session is scheduled to begin. Scratches made during these periods will not count in the individual's participation limitations. However, if the competitor is not scratched during these scheduled periods and does not show to the clerking area before that runner's position is set, the competitor will be disqualified from that event and that event will count toward the competitor's personal limit. The Clerk of Course shall form heats following the last call for that event. Only two of the three contestants listed in the school's entry (with current OUTDOOR times, heights and distances) will be allowed to compete in that individual event. Should one of the three entries not be scratched during or before the scratch period, the Clerks of Course will have the authority to scratch the last listed individual for that school

Scoring:

8 places/8 medals (10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1) Regional Champion Trophy

Running Event Check-In:

All running events will be clerked and athletes must check in at the north end of the track by the 100m start.

Additional Information:

The infield can be used by athletes as a warm up area. No coaches are permitted on the field at any time after the coaches meeting. Athletes may only be on the infield in the event prior to their event for warm up purposes.

Tents/canopies are permitted and can be set up as long as they are set up outside of the track fence. Preferably they would be set up on the North and East end of the track.

Admission:

The MHSAA has decided to manage all ticket sales digitally for Track Regionals through GoFan. Each participating school will receive their own ticket sales link. Helpful Resources: <u>How to Validate Tickets</u> <u>How to Buy Tickets</u> <u>Accessing & Sharing Tickets</u>

Passes:

League passes, coach passes, local booster club passes, official's association passes, etc. will not be honored at any MHSAA Tournament. No passes will be honored except those distributed by the tournament manager for supervision purposes. There will not be free admission for college coaches.

Administration / Crowd Control Passes:

Each school will be issued 5 crowd control passes. Names of all administrators should be e-mailed to Kiersten Gascho (gaschok@think-usa.org) prior to the start of the meet by the participating school's athletic director.

Concessions:

A concession stand will be provided. Hot items available.

Live Streaming:

Fans are reminded that the broadcast and streaming rights of this event belong exclusively to the NFHS Network, MHSAA, and those media outlets which have pre-arranged to secure those rights. Any individual streaming of this event is strictly prohibited. USA is a NFHS partner, so the meet will be streamed on the NFHS Network.
