- All medalist finishers who are not members of a qualifying team will qualify to the State Finals at MIS, regardless if there are three or four qualifying teams.
- Coaches If your team has qualified or you have any individuals going on to the state finals, please make sure that you pick up the info at the regional meet. Information will not be mailed.



All buses and team vehicles should enter through the southernmost entrance (Moorsbridge Elementary). Parents driving athletes need to enter at the middle entrance, or north grass lot.

- Buses and school marked vehicles will arrive starting 7:30 to 8:00.
- Team Vans Team vans should park in the elementary parking lot.
- <u>Division 4 buses</u> Buses should drive as far as possible around the loop. Please park as close and safely as possible behind the next bus, so that we can maximize space.
- <u>Division 1 & 2</u> Please fill in the remainder of the bus loop. If the loop is full, use the drop off lane in front of West MS or Moorsbridge Elem.

<u>Spectator Parking</u> – We will allow spectators to park in the main parking lots in front of Moorsbridge Elementary and West Middle School. An additional grass lot located North of the main parking lot will be available.

<u>Parents transporting athletes</u> – Non-athletes will be charged \$6 even if they are transporting competing athletes. Coaches are not charged admission

<u>Athletes driving themselves</u> – Car pooling is encouraged. Please ask your athletes that are driving themselves to park along Leawood St, which is on the east side of the course. About 2/3 of the way down Leawood is a walkway that leads up to the back side of the course.
