Location

The regional cross country championship will be held at the East Jordan Community Park. The park is located at 805 Maple Street in East Jordan, which is approximately $1 - 1\frac{1}{2}$ miles south of East Jordan High School on M-32 Highway.

Admission

An admission charge of \$6.00 per person or \$10 per car will be charged. Regional Entries

Eight teams per regional (56 entries) and 14 individual qualifiers per gender will comprise the regional. Entries will be transferred from the pre-regional meet to the regional meet via www.athletic.net.

Merchandise/Concessions

Limited concessions will be available and official MHSAA merchandise will be available for purchase on site.

Team Qualifiers to Final Meet

Five runners must finish a Regional run for a school to receive a team score. The top three teams will advance from the Regional to the Finals.

Individual Qualifiers to Final Meet

The next seven individuals not on one of the qualifying teams, per gender per division, will advance to Finals. For a school that advances five or more individuals, but finishes outside of the top three teams, those competitors will not be considered a team but five or more individuals who would compete individually at the Final meet.

Awards

Awards will be presented at the conclusion of the last race in each division. A first place trophy will be presented to each gender in each division. The first place team will receive seven (7) team medals. Fifteen (15) individual medals will be presented in each division for each gender.
