### **Entries**

- □ Teams Your top 7 runners from your Pre-Regional meet have been carried forward to the Regional meet. You may now edit your roster and add an 8<sup>th</sup> runner until Friday, October 30 at noon.
- □ Any runner on your eligibility list may compete.
- On the day of the meet, additional changes can be made at the finish line trailer.
- Only 7 may compete.

### Packet Pick-up, Changes and Substitutions

□ Packet Pick-up will be at the finish line upon arrival to the course.

### **Timing, Scoring & Results**

- □ Timing will be done using a Finish Lynx FAT system.
- □ Bibs Do not alter the bib. They need to be clearly visible during the race.
- □ Coaches please check the unofficial results within the 15 minutes of posting, before they become official. Verify that all of your runners are on the results. Results will be loaded live for you to view.
- Results will be posted at: athletic.net, www.mhsaa.com. We will not be printing results for distribution.

### Awards:

- □ No awards ceremony. Trophies and medals can be picked by coaches at the finish line following the races.
- Medals to top 15 individuals in each race.
- Trophy to first place team in each race. 7 team medals for each runner on the championship team.

### **State Qualifiers**

- □ Top three teams advance to Finals along with top seven individuals not on a team.
- There is no 4<sup>th</sup> team qualifier this year. If a team that places outside of 1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> qualifies 5 or more individuals, these runners will qualify as individuals, not as a team.
- Coaches If your team has qualified or you have any individuals going on to the state finals we will deliver materials to your team area before you leave. Please make sure you have materials before you leave the regional meet. Information will not be mailed.

### **Parking and Admittance for Spectators**

- □ We will be using an online payment system for parking fees. As required by the MHSAA we will charge a fee of \$10.00 per car or \$6 per individual, with a one dollar convenience fee. Please inform all parents, administrators and non-participating athletes of this fee. Please use the provided parking areas near the school. Parents transporting competing athletes will still be charged admission; athletes will not be charged admission.
- □ A uniquely numbered parking pass will be emailed for spectators to print.
- □ A late fee will be assessed to any spectator without a pass and we may hit spectator limits and reject those without prepaid electronic passes.
- □ SPECTATORS/PARENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE ATHLETES VILLAGE.
