## Parking & Team Camps:

The course is located to the south of the Shepherd Veteran's Memorial Field(Football Stadium) and access to the course is available by entering the Stadium and walking to the south. The start is located on the east practice field.

Teams will arrive and park in the parking lot between the Stadium and the Baseball/Softball Complex. Each team will be assigned a Port-A-Potty that is at the south end of this parking lot, please use only the one assigned to you. Your Port-A-Potty assignment is also your Box Number. Bathrooms will be cleaned regularly and please note there will be some overlap between the D4 and D2 teams who share a Port-A-Potty. If your team is not driving a bus please only bring 2-3 cars into the Parking Lot and have the rest park in the overflow lot to the North.

D4 Teams as you arrive please try to park on the South end of this Parking Lot to leave space for the D2 teams to arrive on the North end of this Parking Lot.

If you must setup a tent or make a normal team camp the only spot you may do this is just inside the gate. Reminder that all athletes, coaches and spectators in any areas of the complex must be wearing a mask unless they are athletes competing. If they wish to not wear a mask on their warm up or cool down then this must take place outside the complex.



- **Master Eligibility List:** All Master Eligibility Lists need to be send to the Shepherd Athletic office by 6 PM Friday October 16<sup>th</sup>. Send them to rharkrader@shepherdschools.net or fax to 989-828-5452.
- **Entries:** All entries from Pre Regionals to Regionals will be handled by MichiganCrossCountry.com. Qualifiers from the Pre-Regionals will have a chance to make substitutions if they are team qualifiers. Substitutions for any of these athletes may occur on meet day as long as they are listed on the School's Master Eligibility List. Changes can be made on athletic.net as needed.
- **Qualification:** The top three teams automatically qualify for the Finals meet. The top seven individuals who are not members of one of the three qualifying teams will qualify to the Final meet. There will be no 4<sup>th</sup> Place Team Qualifier in 2020.
- **Timing:** Each competitor will be issued a bib number. The bib must be affixed on their front and use 4 safety pins to secure it. An imaging system will be used to record the time and order of finish. Video backup will also be utilized.
- **Packet/Coaches Meeting:** Packets containing final instructions, bibs, pins course maps and box assignments will be handed out upon arrival in the parking lot.
- **Uniform and Jewelry:** All runners must compete in a legal uniform. It is the coach's responsibility to ensure that runners conform to the MHSAA and National Federation rules for uniforms and jewelry.
- **Results:** Live finish results will be available throughout the meet, <a href="http://anet.live/zkp85c">http://anet.live/zkp85c</a>. Results will be pending up to 45 minutes after that start of each race, at that time they will be marked final. If there are issues with the live results please text 989-506-8556 with the issue. Final results will be online at athletic.net and mhsaa.com. Live stream at www.freetracklive.com
- **Awards:** There will be no awards ceremony in 2020. Awards will be distributed in the Parking Lot once results go final.
- **Admission:** Ticket prices for MHSAA Cross Country tournament events are \$6/person for Regional meets. Tickets will only be available online at a GoFan page. https://gofan.co/app/school/MI3606

Spectators must purchase their tickets online and there is a limit of 1,000 spectators total. All Spectators must wear a mask at all times.

- **Clothing:** Official souvenir clothing will be available for purchase from the MHSAA's clothing vendor EA Graphics. If items are sold out they can be purchased online at eagraphics.com.
- **Animals & Pets**: Animals are not allowed at MHSAA events unless for Medical reasons.
- **Spectator Parking:** Spectators may park in the paved lots to the east of the Football Stadium, Parking Lot #1. Additional parking will also be available in the High School Parking Lots #4 & #5 to the north east of the Football Stadium/Cross Country Course. (See Attached Maps)
- **Restrooms:** The Football Stadium restrooms will be open and Port-A-Potties will be located closer to the Start of the course. (See Attached Maps)
- **Local Restaurants**: Great dining options are available at the Shepherd Bar & Restaurant, Mitchell's Gourmet Deli and McDonalds.
