



Congratulations on advancing to the 2021-2022 MHSAA LP Division 4 Girls Tennis Finals. Here is a list of things you will need to know prior to arriving for this year's event:

- We will be using **Three** sites, University of Michigan Varsity Tennis Center, Ann Arbor Pioneer High School and Ann Arbor Greenhills High School for the first day of the tournament. If you did not have three coaches listed on your regional coaches' form, and intend to use three coaches, please email the names of all of your coaches to jtippett2@comcast.net and indicate which one is your head coach. This is **mandatory** for the creation of coaching badges that each of the coaches will need. For day two only, one site will be used and two coaches will be allowed per team. Each team that advances to Saturday play will be required to surrender one coaching badge to the tournament desk. Please make sure that any coach that will be utilized has completed the necessary MHSAA rules meeting.
- Coaches of teams/individual qualifiers may pick up their name badges between 7:00 am and 7:30 am at the University of Michigan site on Friday, June 3, 2022.
- Play will begin on Friday, June 3 at UM at 8:00 am and at Pioneer High School and Greenhills High School at 8:30 am. Please coordinate your own transportation to Pioneer and Greenhills for doubles players as transportation will not be provided.
- Saturday matches will start at 8:00 am and will all be at UM.
- In case of inclement weather, teams should report to the UM Varsity Tennis Center.
- The high school buildings will be off limits to all. Please do not try to access the buildings during the school day.
- Practice courts will be available on Thursday on a first come, first served basis. There are 12 courts at Pioneer High school. Parking there is in the large lot near the access road off of South Main St. There are 8 courts at Greenhills. If you wish to reserve courts at the UM Varsity Tennis Center you will have to pay applicable fees and it is subject to availability.
- MHSAA rules regarding team uniforms will be enforced throughout the tournament.
- Point penalty system will be enforced. Keep in mind that code violations from the Regional Tournament carry over into the State Tournament.
