No outside food or beverages are allowed to be brought into the bowling center

Valuables

Please do not bring in any of your valuables (iPads, iPods, etc.) to the bowling center. The MHSAA, Oak Lanes or Marian High School cannot be responsible for lost or stolen items.

Regional Format

Team – All teams will bowl 6 Baker games and 3 Regular Games on alternating lanes with the Top three teams in each Regional advancing to the Finals.

Singles – All singles entrants will bowl six regular games with total pins determining score. The top 10 in each Regional advancing to the MHSAA Finals.

Coaching Restrictions

Two school coaches will be allowed in the bowlers' seating area during competition. Coaches are not allowed on the approaches. Additional coaches must be in the spectator area. Coaching is allowed only between frames. A maximum of 2 coaches will be allowed with each team. All others need to pay admissions.

Tournament Entry, Team:

A school may enter only one team in the MHSAA tournament and that team may have a maximum of 7 members on the roster. Five students constitutes a team for the MHSAA tournament competition

Tournament Entry, Singles:

School may enter a maximum of six (6) bowlers in each gender in the singles portion of the MHSAA Tournament.

Uniform/Dress Code

Boys – Slacks and a collared shirt or mock turtleneck are required.

Girls – Slacks, shorts or skirt with a collared shirt or mock turtleneck are required. Skirts must reach the top of the knee and shorts shall be an appropriate length. No yoga pants.

All – No jeans, cutoffs, sweatpants or warm-up pants. Also no hats, caps or any type of headgear are allowed.

Coaches must also adhere to the MHSAA uniform/dress code regulations.

Practice

Bowlers may practice at Oak Lanes prior to the MHSAA Regional dates during normal open bowling time at normal rates. No practice is allowed on days of MHSAA competition.
