Tournament Rules

MHSAA tournament rules: See MHSAA.com Bowling for Tournament Participants and Manager Information. Two (2) balls allowed in the bowling area with one ball allowed on the ball return at a time. All other bowling balls and bags are to be in the paddock area. USBC rules will govern this event. This is not a sanctioned USBC event.

Cost: Payment for bowling MUST be done prior to competition. **Please make checks payable to Town** and Country Lanes. You may send them prior to the tournament or to the Huron Athletic Department, 32044 Huron River Drive, New Boston 48164. You may also bring them to registration on tournament day. *<u>PAYMENT IS REQUIRED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE TOURNAMENT</u>.

Lineage is **\$ 2.25 per game**. Team event consists of 21 games per team or 42 games per school. A full compliment of 6 individuals bowling 6 games of singles results in 36 games per team or 72 games per school. A school sending a full squad will bowl 114 games and owe a grand total of **\$ 256.50**. Schools sending less than 6 bowlers for singles may deduct \$ 13.50 for each bowler under the allowable 6.

Admission

There will be a <u>\$6.00 admission</u> for all spectators (adults, students and children). Similar to all MHSAA tournaments, we have included **4** administrators' passes for your school administrators or board **member and coaches spouses.** Please inform your parents and spectators of this admission charge to avoid problems at the tournament.

Format

On **Friday**, the TEAM format will consist of three (3) Baker sets (2 Baker games in each set) and three (3) regular games. On **Saturday**, SINGLES: Each bowler will bowl a six (6) game block, Total pin count. Tie breaker in SINGLES will be one (1) game roll off. TEAM will be one set (2 games) of Baker. In a tie breaker the **TOTAL pins which will not be added to the team or singles total, but to just break the tie. You may bring a maximum of seven (7) members for team event and six (6) for singles.**

Tournament - Practice

There will be fifteen (15) minutes for the TEAM on Friday. You will receive seven and one half (7 1/2) minutes on each lane. There will be a ten (10) minutes of practice prior to the start of the SINGLES on Saturday.

Pre - Tournament Practice

Town and Country Lanes will schedule dates in which they will put out the tournament shot for any team wishing to come in and practice. Coaches may call the Center to determined dates and times for tournament practice.

Lane Conditions

The event will be bowled using the Kegel "Allen Pattern". The lanes will be conditioned before every squad.

Entry Forms

The MHSAA Rosters, Boys and Girls; and the Master Eligibility form are due on Friday, February 7th. This is also the opt-out date. *Please mail the forms to Huron High School Athletic Department,* 32044 Huron River Drive, New Boston 48164. Please PRINT NAMES CLEARLY.

Lane Assignment

The Regional Manager will make lane assignments by random draw prior to the tournament. Lane assignments will be posted at check in and a copy given out at the coaches meeting.

Lane Rotation

Team event teams: Odd lanes move left and even lanes right. Singles: All rotate right after each game.

Dress Code

Boys- Slacks are required. Jeans, cutoffs, shorts, sweatpants or warm-up pants will NOT be allowed. A collared shirt or mock turtle neck will be required. T-Shirts will not be allowed. **Girls-**Slacks, shorts, or skirts will be allowed. Skirts must reach the top of the knee and shorts shall be an appropriate length. Jeans, cutoffs, sweatpants or warm-up pants will NOT be allowed. <u>Yoga Pants</u> <u>may NOT be worn.</u> A collared shirt or mock turtle neck will be required. T-shirts will not be allowed, however mock turtle neck shirts allowed for both and limited jewelry. No Coaches or participants may wear hats, caps, or any other headgear.

Coaching Restrictions

Per MHSAA 2 school approved coaches per gender will be allowed in the bowlers' area during competition. Additional coaches may be seated directly behind the lanes at the table. Coaches are **not** allowed on the approaches. Additional coaches must be in the spectator area. Coaching is allowed **only** between frames. Coaches must wear their designated tournament identification badge during competition. Coaches must be in school uniform and display tournament identification lanyards.

Sportsmanship

Good sportsmanship for players and coaches is a must. Taunting, profanity, and intimidating conduct are not allowed. All MHSAA regulations regarding sportsmanship and disqualifying penalties as stated in Regulation IV, Section 3 will be followed. Players will not be allowed to approach to congratulate or celebrate the accomplishments of a fellow team member during bowling. Bowlers will not be allowed to enter an adjacent approach to celebrate or "run out" their delivery. Bowlers shall observe traditional bowling courtesy for bowler on adjacent lanes. Please inform your spectator of the following sportsmanship rules. No noisemakers are allowed. No spectators allowed in bowler's area. No flash cameras are allowed. Cheers should be positive.

Alcohol and Tobacco

No alcohol or tobacco is allowed in the bowling and spectators area during a MHSAA contest.

Food

No outside food or drink is to be brought in the Bowling Center. Town and Country Lanes has numerous eating options available.

Paddock:

At check in, bowlers will be informed of paddock area. Storage of bowling balls is NOT available. The Bowling Center, MHSAA or host school is NOT RESPONSIBLE for lost or stolen items. Do not leave valuables, i.e. phones, iPad, iPhone etc. in paddock area.

In settling all disputes, the tournament directors will make all final decisions.
