**MHSSCA PROPOSALS**

**1. Clarify/confirm the language for helmets.**

Current language is: Each racer must have a helmet which completely covers the head (no soft ears) and is manufactured for ski racing. All slalom racers must have a face guard/face mask on their helmet.

Change to: Helmets designed and manufactured for the particular discipline of ski racing are required for all competitors and forerunners in all events and official training. Helmets must completely cover the head (no soft ears). Slalom racers must have a face guard/face mask on the helmet.

Refer to the rules meeting on MHSAA.com to view pictures of helmets that are legal and not legal for competition.

**2. Add the word regional to 8D, page 15 of the MHSAA Ski Coaches Manual.** It now reads: Each team in the MHSAA Regional and Final Meet must provide two workers (ski or hill qualified) for each gender for both morning and afternoon events....

**3. Reminders for post season meets:**

- A) Student athletes cannot set a course for the Regional or the Final Meet
- B) Course setting is done on Sunday afternoon/evening for the Final Meet – if you want to assist with the setting, contact the host manager and be there on Sunday.
- C) Hand timing – in the event that a hand time is needed, use the three times just before and the three times just after the skier (who needs the hand time).
